Theme of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

The Solemnity we celebrate today is not an invitation to decipher the profound mystery behind “one God in three persons,” but rather a call to contemplation. We are invited to turn our gaze toward the God who is love, who is family, who is community — a God who lives in perfect communion and who created men and women to participate in this mystery of love and unity.

The first reading invites us to contemplate God the Creator, whose goodness and love are inscribed in the wonders of creation. The beauty and harmony of the world are visible signs of His presence and care. Jesus Christ, identified as the “Wisdom” of God, is the supreme revealer of this creative and redemptive love, which acts with tenderness and justice.

In the second reading, Saint Paul presents the God who loves us deeply and who, out of sheer generosity, justifies and saves us. It is through the Son that the Father’s gifts are poured out upon us, offering us fullness of life, true joy, and renewed hope. The Holy Spirit, in turn, is the source of this new life and the one who unites the community, distributing gifts for the common good and the building up of the Church.

The Gospel once again calls us to contemplate the love of the Father, manifested in the generous gift of the Son, and which continues to act in the world through the constant presence of the Holy Spirit.
